Donna Beckman has been an owner/exhibitor/breeder of Siberian Huskies for 40 years.



She has served the Siberian Husky Club of America, Inc., in many elected and appointed capacities, including as President, Show Chairman, Newsletter Editor, SHCA's Delegate to the American Kennel Club. Currently she is SHCA Judges' Education Chairman and a member of the Illustrated Standard Committee. In 2012, she was honored by SHCA as the recipient of the Peggy Grant Award for lifetime service to the Club and the Breed, and in 2014 she was named a Life Member of SHCA.

Although only mushing recreationally, Donna and her husband Ric have been avid supporters of many Iditarod teams, and Ric rode the second sled for the Alaskan-Anadyr team at the Ceremonial Start of the 1999 Iditarod. Donna is the co-breeder many, many Champions in the USA and in foreign countries. She is co-breeder and/or co-owner of multiple Best in Show, Group-winning, Group-

placing, and highly ranked Siberian Huskies in the US and several foreign countries, including a 32-time US Best-in-Show winner, SHCA Top-20 winner, and Award of Merit winners at National Specialties. She is the author of a book on the Siberian. She is approved by the AKC to judge a number of breeds, and has judged and educated fanciers and judges in the US and other countries, including having judged the SHCA National Specialty.
